DIY Plant pumpkins in early summer near the edge of your garden. Space pumpkin plants 2 to 5 feet apart (depending on the variety). Grow each pumpkin on a 3-foot wide mound of warm, fertile soil that has a pH of 6.0 to 6.8. Improve your native soil by mixing in several inches of aged compost or other rich organic matter. It's recommended that you plan on a minimum of 20 square feet (2 sq. m.) being needed for each plant. When the soil temperature is at least 65 F. (18 C.), you can plant your pumpkin seeds. Pumpkin seeds won't germinate in cold

soil. Pumpkin Growing - How And When To Plant Pumpkin Seeds Pumpkins do best when the seeds are planted directly in the ground. Wait until the plant soil is 70°F or more before sowing seeds outdoors.
