The total mangrove area in CONUS in 2015 was 251,293 ha with 98.1% of mangrove area in Florida, 0.6% in Louisiana, and 1.3% in Texas. As expected, mangrove occurrence generally decreased with increasing latitude from south to north. For example, approximately 85% of the CONUS mangrove area was found between 24.5° to 26.0° latitude.
