A: Almost all weather conditions begin because of the sun. High pressure system - A high pressure system generally means good weather because it attracts cool and dry air. On a weather map a high pressure system is shown by a blue H. CONCEPT Weather forecasters use advanced technologies. Modern meteorologists wouldn't be nearly so accurate without numerical forecasting, which uses mathematical equations to predict the weather. Such forecasting requires powerful computers and lots of observational data collected from land, sea and air. A single weather station would never be able to collect so much information. Why can't scientists accurately predict the weather ... As a general rule, longterm or seasonal forecasting tricks are worthless. Anything that claims to be able to predict weather more than a few days out can nearly always be safely ignored. But some short-term techniques do have value. There are many reliable weather clues to be
